### ACCESSIBILITY

If your pet has an emergency, you may need to get to the vet quickly. Choose one that's a reasonable distance from home.

#### Also check if your vet has:

- Easy accessAccommodations
- Flexible hours



#### RELATIONSHIP

Your vet should make you feel welcomed and comfortable. They should listen to your concerns and answer all of your questions.

You can test your comfort level with a phone call. The way the receptionist talks to you can be a great example of the relationship a clinic offers.



### **AMENITIES**

Think about the services that are important to you.

- House calls
- Alternative medicine
- Specialty services
  Separate cat and dog facilities

#### REPUTATION

Ask friends and neighbours. Ask a shelter or veterinary specialist. This will give you an idea about who the professionals respect.

Take online reviews with a grain of salt. People often write negative reviews when they receive bad news.
